The sites are typically awarded each season by random draw of applications received by the draw deadline date. Quetico; Crooked; Tanner; Cirrus; Minn; Iron Wolseley; Beaverhouse; McAree; Poohbah Aircraft landings may also occur on Beaverhouse & Poohbah Lakes.		

Ontario Fishing Licences (HST Inclusive)	
The new (LAS) licencing automation system replaced the manual paper-based licences and will not be sold at all Quetico Park ranger stations. The three stations selling licences are Dawson Trail, Cache Bay & Prairie Portage. Licences will not be sold at Beaverhouse, Lac La Croix or Atikokan Entry. Plan ahead to purchase a fishing licence prior to arrival at ontario.ca/outdoorscard . A \$2.00 (+hst) service fee will apply to the purchase of all licences and Outdoors Cards. * Only barbless hooks and artificial bait can be used for fishing in Quetico Park.
